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

A demo of hands on training was also provided to the staff involved in the exam. Exam Centre Suptd. Sh. Mahesh



It had 111 learners allotted on the day of visit. Total 78 learners were present and 33 were absent.




Mr. Krishna Deo Thakur, AE (DP) visited exam centre 08026 (Pillar) on 24.02.202.
