3. Assignments and its importance.



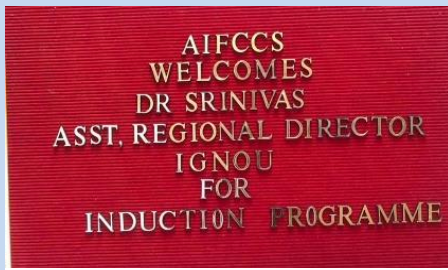

8. Identification of webinar themes etc.

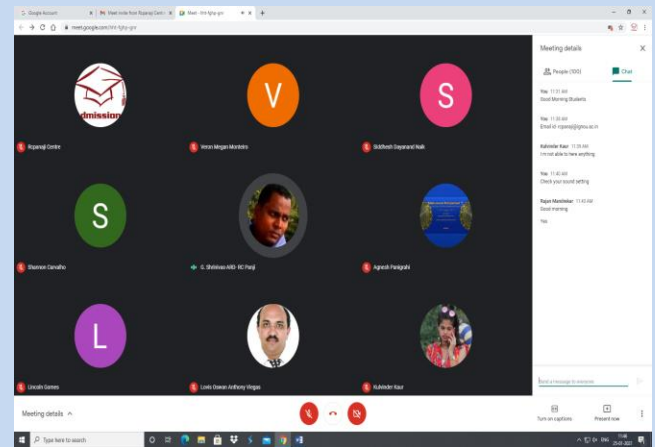
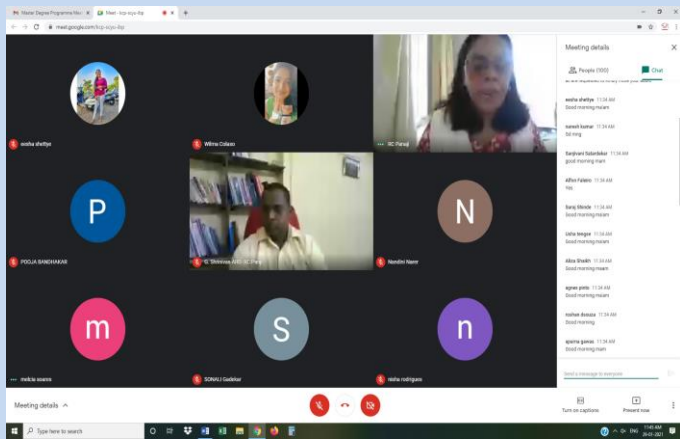
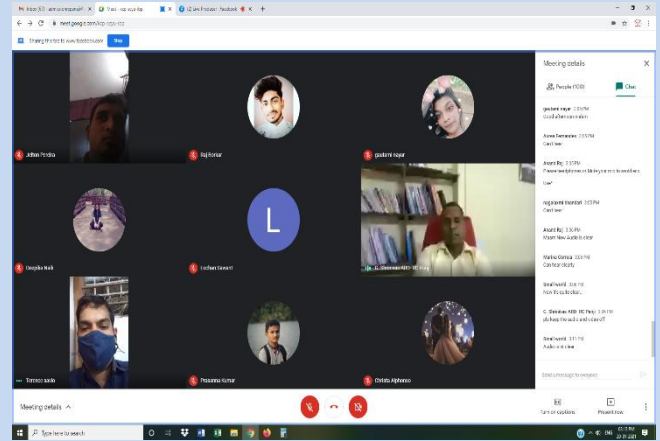
The Principal readily agreed to conduct the seminar in the third week of February 2020.
